Improvements by corridor:

I-496 – Bridge Work

- Improvements to 33 bridges between Waverly Road and US-127, along with concrete pavement repairs along I-496.
- Lane closures will take place at non-peak times, including nights and weekends.

M-99 (Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard) – Road Work

- One mile of pavement will be resurfaced between the Grand River bridge and Victor Avenue, along with sidewalk ramp upgrades.
- At least one lane of traffic will be open in each direction during construction.

US-127 – Bridge Work

- Improvements to three bridges between Lake Lansing Road and I-69.
- Bridge work will begin in fall 2012 with repairs to the US-127 bridge over an abandoned railroad track near State Road. The work will require a single-lane closure in each direction on US-127 for a maximum of five days. No work will take place during home football games at Michigan State University.
- The remaining bridge work will take place starting in spring 2013 with repairs to Lake Lansing Road over US-127, and State Road over US-127.
- On Lake Lansing Road, two westbound lanes of traffic will be open and one eastbound lane will be open during construction.
- For State Road traffic, the bridge will be closed and a detour posted.
- On US-127, two lanes will be open in each direction with a traffic shift.

S.B. US-127 – Auxiliary Lanes

- Auxiliary lanes will be added along southbound US-127 in two locations: between Lake Lansing Road and M-43 (Grand River Avenue), and between M-43 (Saginaw Street) and the I-496 ramps.
- The work will be similar to the auxiliary lanes added along northbound US-127 in 2012 in the same locations.
- Two lanes will be open on southbound US-127 with a shoulder closure and traffic shift during construction.

M-43 (Grand River Avenue) – Road Work

- Construction on M-43 (Grand River Avenue) will stretch between Coolidge Road and Park Lake Road, in Meridian Township.
- During construction, at least one lane of traffic will be open in each direction on M-43. Access to business and residents will be maintained at all times during the project.
- Construction involves resurfacing the roadway, along with intersection improvements and traffic signal upgrades.
- In addition, an 8-foot-wide pedestrian path will be added on both sides of M-43 between Bogue Street and Brookfield Drive, just east of Hagadorn Road.

Michigan Avenue – Road Work

- Construction on Michigan Avenue will stretch from Harrison Road to the M-43 (Grand River Avenue) split.
- The Harrison Road and Beal Street intersections will be reconfigured.
- At least one lane of traffic will be open in each direction on Michigan Avenue during construction.


